The Vancouver JCCA Redress Committee shall be a subcommittee of the Board of the Vancouver JCCA. Tomales Is 1) 2. It shall represent the Greater Vancouver Japanese Canadian community on matters pertaining to redress at both the local and national levels. 3. It shall disseminate information in the Greater Vancouver Japanese Canadian community on the redress program through a) ay public meetings, b) regular reports in the Bulletin , c) and other media outlets. 4. It shall advise and make recommendations to the JCCA Board of Directors on policy decisions pertaining to redress matters. DOES THIS MEAN THIS IS NOT AN AUTOCOTTIC 5. It shall assist, wherever feasible, the JCCA Board of Directors in the fund-raising campaign for the JCCA redress program. 6. It shall send the alternate delegate to National Association ONS of Japanese Canadians (NAJC) Council meetings to advise the NAJC Council member from the JCCA Board of Directors on the Greater Vancouver Japanese Canadian position on redress.
