


Dear Mr. Omokawa,

Further to a concersation with your Mr. Hirasawa in my office this week, when the strawberry pack of your association was discussed.

It is indeed gratifying to see an association strive to maintain a standard pack throughout as your association is trying to do. My inspectors report that while your pack this past season has been generally good, some crates of strawberries were found to be faced with British Sovereigns and underneath were 122 strawberries, the crate being marked with the British Sovereign label. I do not know if the 122 berries were placed intentionally or not but it would appear to be so, as these were underneath. Your growers must understand that when the British Sovereign label is used, that all berries in the crate must be British Sovereign. Growers cannot take too much care in selecting berries of uniform maturity and packing same carefully. Overfacing cannot be tolerated as the face of the pack must be representative of the pack throughout the crate. A good, well filled, honest pack will always sell quicker and bring bigger returns to growers. An association is known by the quality of its pack.

Another thing I wish to draw to the attention of your Directors, is the Fruit Act requires that all packages must be marked with the name and address of association with a growers number. In the case of your association you have no address on the package and trust you will have this remedied before another season starts.

I have received your letter dated November 25th, in which you state that Mr. Saburo Shigehiro has left a large amount of straw on his property upon evacuation. You have stated that the neighbors said that I have taken the straw from Mr. Shigehiro's property. Not, I, Myself, but the association took the straw ~~from~~ ^{ed} his property since the association bought the straw with its own money. The Surrey Berry Growers had supplied Mr. Shigehiro with straw for the summer berry crop, but due to evacuation, he did not use it, as the Association did not have enough money which was due from him, the association took his straw and sold it. The association was broken up, so we had nothing to do with straw. The only thing I would like you to do is to send Mr. Shigehiro the Custodian has nothing to do with the straw.







We wish to acknowledge your letter of the 3rd January, and note your inquiry regarding the above Association. Please be advised that the property of this association has not been liquidated in any way in 1942 and the first part of 1943, the services were rented to Mr. C. C. Klein in consideration of the payment of taxes on the property, and from 1st October, 1943 to 30th September, 1945, the premises were used by the Custodian for the auctioning of Japanese chattels in that locality, for which the Custodian credited the Association's account with the sum of \$10.00 per month for that period. Since that time, the property has not been used and the caretaker has been allowed to live in the back portion in consideration for looking after the buildings and to assure no breaking and entering.

We have attached hereto a statement of the Association's account at this office which we trust you find satisfactory, and (you) you will note that H. Y. Inman's Mortgage loan repayment plus interest has been credited to the account. Insurance premiums have been paid from the account as they became due together with an additional premium in the amount of \$26.25, which was paid in view of the fact that it was considered advisable to increase the insurance on the premises for an additional \$1,150.00 in view of the increased cost of building now. The 1944 taxes were also paid but it is noted that the 1945 taxes were overlooked. However this will be paid in due course upon receiving a copy of the tax notice.
