I have travelled to Vancouver to attend the meeting of the Home Mission of our Church with no trouble by which granted by your Security Commission. As I travelled in the daytime mostly, I should thank you for your kind consideration.

Might I suggest and draw your attention regarding to the evacuation of this district population that we have six hundred and thirty three are living in this area. It is, I believe, quite adequate to send a boat to Union Bay, which is about center of this area, to get those people at Union Bay when Vancouver Island east coast evacuations will take place.

I have met Mr. Morie and promised with him that until we receive a ~~written~~ official document to order our removal we will keep ~~at~~ in Calm.



This is a petition regard to the transportation of the evacuation of this district's people. Although I have had several communications with you in connection of this matter, I would like to call your attention on this matter again and ask you to reconsider on the every detail in the following items:

- 1)...One hundred and fifty men...16 year up. Including thirty over 60 year old men. Four hundred and fifty women and children....
- 2)...Localities: including 150 school-ages; 50 infants.

- 3)... Nearest Station: COURTENAY, CUMBERLAND, FANNY BAY, Royston.

- 4)... Transferring so often: Fanny Bay Station For Fanny Bay People. Inconvenient to get to station. We have to take Taxi to the station. At Parksville: Train to train.

- 5)... Majority of old men and women never been out of this district, another word they are not use to travelling.

- 6)... If it is impossible to send special boat to Union Bay, please send an official up and arrange the Groupe entrain everyday.

- 7)... Cumberland civilians kindly have started to get certain number of cars with which they will take us (400 people) to Union Bay voluntarily. Approx. 50-60 cars and 5 trucks. Cumberland to Union Bay is 10 miles.

Dear Sir:-

In the Comox District of Vancouver Island with the exception of women and a few permit holders most of whom are invalids all Japanese aliens have already evacuated. Those who remain, consisting of in the most part naturalized subjects and Niseis, are now prepared to leave upon notice being under the direction of Mr. T. Kagetsu, a member of the Sub-committee in charge of evacuation.

Unfortunately, in this district I own a logging operation and have now in the woods timber felled to the extent of 2,500,000 feet log measure. Should these logs not be removed before this summer damage from insect attack will make the products almost valueless. On the other hand continued logging will result in marketing to eager buyers the chief of whom being H.R. MacMillan interests.

Should occidental labor be available my problems will be solved. The misfortune is that although I now employ five of these men I cannot obtain more by reason of the existing labor shortage and because of the short period of notice at my disposal. I wish to respectfully request, therefore, that through your thoughtful consideration special permission be granted to twenty-three (23) men either Niseis or naturalized Canadians so that I may hire them for two months to complete the operation. In return for your kindness I am willing to accept full responsibility for the hired persons and shall employ them only on condition that upon expiration of their permits they obey whatever is ordered by your commission. I shall submit to you a detailed list of the men concerned including in addition to their names and registration numbers any information required.

I greatly realize the value of your time and that people are constantly presenting their personal problems to you but your favorable consideration to the above will be immensely appreciated.

The following may also be of help: I was naturalized in November 12, 1909; my registration number is 00014; am a member of the above mentioned Sub-committee; my 1941 Dominion Income Tax was \$1,808.82; and finally Land and School Taxes exceed \$3,000 annually.

Although we are expecting to leave this district any-time when we receive an official notice, we have not heard anything yet. Would ~~kindly~~ you kindly wire us when you get instruction regarding this district's evacuation please. And we will be appreciated if you would reconsider the following points which will make the evacuation smoother and easier in the capacity:

1).....We have 585 population in this district, namely Cumberland, Royston, Courtenay, Headquarter, Union Bay and Fanny Bay.

Above 16 Men.....178, Women.....~~247~~ 106.
School children..207, Under 6...64.
Above 60..... 29,

2).....We heard that C.P.R. boat did not allowed to use the State-room when the Port Alberni people on board, even though they have tried to pay by their own expense. We have so many old folks and infants who should be given adequat accommodation on board, if Commission will provide the special boat. Please make complete arrangement with the Commission, and let us use the state-room of the boat. Estimate time of sail is between 7 and 8 hours from Union Bay to Vancouver. (I believe that everybody does not mind to pay for the state room by their own expense, if The commission would not provide it)

3).....We local committee wish to have the official permit to remain for few days after the mass moved out.

Wish you could understand what I was trying to say and do the best you can. We extend our heartily gratitude towards your tireless endeavour to this problem. We wish you will on your best of health, thank you,


