Your letter of the 16th instant addressed to our Mr. Hatley, General Freight Agent, Vancouver B.C., regarding the above matter has been referred to us.

We regret that we cannot see our way clear to handle freight bills on the log haul on above mentioned operation direct to the Stoltze Logging Co., Ltd., Box 474 Duncan, B.C.

Credit privileges established in your favor at Cowichan Bay are in accordance with regulations of the Railway Association of Canada, and call for accounts to be rendered on the 7th 14th 21st and last day of each month, with payments to be made on or before the 14th 21st and last day of the month and the 7th of the following month respectively, and that bills are to be paid within the prescribed period at the designated office of the Carrier at which credit was established which, in this case, is Vancouver. No credit privileges are granted to the Stoltze Logging Co., Ltd., at Duncan.

Monthly or semi-monthly basis of settlement, we regret, cannot be given consideration, as we cannot deviate in any way from the established regulations regarding the granting of credit. We would appreciate, therefore, if you could arrange for these accounts to be paid in accordance with established credit regulations, and we feel that this can be done by our Agent at Cowichan Bay forwarding expense bills to your Vancouver office and payment made direct to our Local Freight Agent at that point.
