12,000 ASIATIC WORKERS IN B.C.
Percentage Reaches 10 Per Cent of Total

VICTORIA, Oct. 2.—The percentage of Asiatics employed in British Columbia shows an increase for the first time since 1926 and now stands at 10 per cent, according to figures presented at the Parliament Buildings to show the nationality of workers employed in the province. The percentage has increased from 9.8 the previous year. Latest figures show the actual number of Asiatics employed is 12,219, an increase of 1509 in a year. Chinese employees increased to 281. Hindus to 174 and Japanese to 1113 to a 17 per cent period.

The number of employees who are natives of English-speaking countries decreased from 22,450 per cent to 20,342 in the same period. Europe increased to 18,346 from 17,702 per cent. Natives of Canada and Newfoundland also increased from 38,651 per cent to 39,271 per cent. The percentage of those from the British Isles showed a drop in the latest figures from 30.85 to 28.73.

Y.W.C.A. SEEKS TO RAISE \$15,000

Increased and new donations to the Y.W.C.A. campaign are necessary if the \$15,000 objective is to be reached and the social work of that organization continued until the first distribution to the needy is made, probably about May 1, 1931.

In making this fact Austin C. Taylor, member of the Y. finance, advisory committee, points out that in past years the organization has been able to get along on the \$10,000 or \$11,000 actually raised in the \$15,000 drive.

A commitment, however, has increased the financial burden of the young women's association, particularly in the way of free meals.

Mr. Taylor points out, in consequence, that the fall \$15,000 now asked will be required to meet the bare minimum of need for the Y.W.C.A.

Parachute Saves Airman in Crash

KANSAS CITY, Oct. 2.—Lieut. John M. Cross of Wichita joined The Caterpillar Club today, when he jumped to safety with a parachute after a collision between his army reserve corps plane and a fast military monoplane piloted by Lieut. James E. Doolittle, former army flyer.

Cross' plane was demolished. Doolittle landed safely with only a bent propeller and dents on the front of the fuselage as remainder of the crash, 100 feet above the earth.

Three Divorces Granted by Court

Decree absolute of divorce has been granted by Mr. Justice D. A. McLeod to Helen Jean O'Brien, 507 1/2 Park Street, in trial of action against Henry E. O'Brien. The marriage was performed at New Westminster March 15, 1917.

Heather Russell of Vancouver has also been granted an absolute decree of divorce acting against William M. Russell. C. N. Hanes appeared for the petitioner. His wife appeared for the respondent at Vancouver December 13, 1927.

Gilbert McKenzie was granted an absolute decree of divorce against Annie D. S. McKenzie as trial of action in which Alan Moore was cited co-respondent.

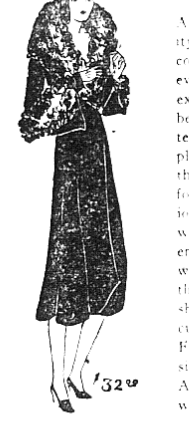
