## TRADE DELEGATION GETS BIG WELCOME

### Goodwill Speeches Feature Banquet in Tokyo

TOKYO, Japan, Oct. 30.—Members of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce trade delegation to the Orient were paid a unique tribute last night when they were honored at a dinner in Japanese style by the Japanese and Tokyo Chamber of Commerce.

The visitors sat on the floor with their backs to the wall and were served individually by yudai girls.

Later in the evening Canadian and Japanese flags were unfurled by colorful banners.

Brief goodwill speeches were made by Baron Ochi, president of the Japanese Chamber of Commerce, Hon. Herbert Marler, Canadian Minister to Japan, and John M. Innes, chairman of the delegation.

The visit of the delegation to Japan is being featured in Japanese newspapers with front page articles.

The majority of addresses are being reported verbatim.

Mr. Marler and Japanese authorities are agreed that the mission so far has been conspicuously successful.

Mr. Innes, O. R. Leckie of Montreal, and W. Mel. Clarke of Montreal, secretary of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce, were guests of honor at a meeting of the Tokyo Rotary Club today.

Mr. Innes addressed the gathering on "International Understanding."
