MAYOR TAYLOR'S CASTING VOTE SAVES BINGHAM FROM DISMISSAL; BOARD REAPPOINTS McLAUGHLIN

Commissioner McLean Moves Resolution Dispensing With Services of Chief on Month's Notice

MOVE HOTLY OPPOSED BY WEEKS, MAHON AND L. D.

Ex-Detective-Sergeant George McLaughlin was reinstated as detective on the city police force and Chief W. J. Bingham was saved from instant dismissal with one month's salary by the casting vote of Mayor L. D. Taylor in a meeting of the Police Commission today, *
The vote for McLaughlin's engagement and

Bingham's retention found Commissioners C. E.
Mahon and A. C. J. Weeks supporting His Worship
and Commissioners Norman McLean and Harry Burgess on the losing side.

The ostensible reason given by McLean for moving for Bingham's displacement was that he had recommended that McLaughlin be taken back on the force as detective.

RESOLUTION OF DISMISSAL

But the resolution he submitted, seconded by Burgess, had been carefully typed out before the meeting and set out:

"Whereas we are of the opinion that the Chief Con-stable (W. J. Bingham) is not a fit and proper person to hold the position that he now occupies in this city, for reasons which we will not enum-erate at this time;

"Be it reslved that he be asked to resign and that one month's salary be paid to him in lieu of notice."

"That," said His Worship to the resolution movers, "is

Without further remark the yote was taken.

Intimating that he thought McLean was working for the advancement of some other member of the force, the Mayor told him that "If I followed my own views (but I'm not going 5) I would move that the services of another man close to the chief be also dispensed with."
