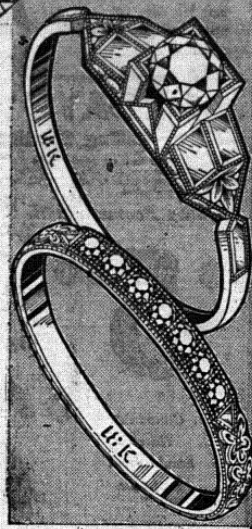

Catalonians Defy Martial Law; All Jails Thrown Open

Barcelona Worries Republican Government

PARIS, April 17.—The French government officially presented the new Spanish republic today, being the first major step to be taken.

BARCELONA, Spain, April 17.—All prisoners were released from jails here today by rioters who swept through the streets without interference. Police were disarmed to take action, despite the sentence of martial law.

MADRID, April 17.—At the conclusion of a lengthy cabinet conference over the Catalonia demand for independence last night, Minister of State Alejandro Lerroux said that the situation was being handled out but that the Madrid Government would not hesitate to use force in preventing the possible secession of Catalonia and the dismemberment of Spain.

Abolition of the Upper House of the Cortes has been decreed by the Government. This consisted of 110 members appointed by the King as those enjoying senatorial rank, by virtue of their station in life, such as such as cardinals, bishops, etc., and the president of the army and navy and the president of the Supreme Court.

Three ministers of the new Republican Government today left by airplane for Barcelona, to negotiate with "Colonel" Francisco Franco, the president of the Catalan republic, to prevent the secession of Catalonia from Spain proper.

King Alfonso's manifesto declaring he was not abdicating but was merely suspending his power temporarily to await the final verdict of the people was published in Spain for the first time yesterday.

It was accompanied by a government note stating that the King assured the loyalty of the new regime on the part of the entire nation that they had no fear of the seizure of royal property.

MADRID, April 17.—Millions of dollars' worth of property in possession of the deposed royal family is being inventoried by the new Republican Government with a view to disposing of it. Crown jewels are not included among the valuables.

French planes are reported to be flying over the Royal family's private possessions, including 12 palaces in various cities, and to retain in the national treasury such items as are considered property of the state.

PARIS CHECKS ALFONSO
PARIS, April 17.—Alfonso de Borbon, until last Tuesday King of the deposed monarchy in Europe, departed from a train at the Gare de Lyon last night into the most cordial reception that old railway station has seen in many years.

Fully 20,000 persons jammed the station and the great square on which it faces.

"Vive le Roi!" the French cried, mingling their cheers with the "Vive le Roi!" of the Spanish Loyalists.

RESCUED BY POLICE
Alfonso was almost crushed by the crowd.

A wedge of police forced about the King and his party and literally pushed them into the waiting train. Alfonso dashed away toward the hotel where Queen Victoria and five of their children awaited him.

Japanese Falls From C.P.R. Liner
VICTORIA, April 17.—Monsieur Chretien was starting the official reception to the Japanese royal party here. Thursday night, when the Japanese Emperor, Hirohito, boarded the Empress of Japan from Seattle, he fell into the water from under the wooden pier to the further side, then grasping a pile until a rope was lowered. He was placed in hot blankets. Medical examination showed he was not dangerously hurt.

Shunkichi Sakurada, T. Hironaka and Shinichi Fujino, charged with the murder of Naoki Watanabe, who was found dead March 30 on the C. P. R. right-of-way in the 800 block Railway Street, were remanded to April 22 for preliminary hearing when they appeared before Magistrate H. C. Shaw in Police Court today.

Hironaka appeared in a near state of collapse and was taken to hospital. He is said to be suffering from a severe attack of influenza.
