Ottawa Given Week to Reply City Demands Voice On Security Board

News that there is no room for a City Hall spokesman on the advisory board to the B.C. Security Commission struck the City Council to bitter expressions of resentment, Monday, with hints of more forceful protests to come.

Offended aldermen resolved to give the Dominion Government one week to respond to their request for a voice in the dispersal of local Japanese. If no answer is received before civic social services committee meets next Monday several aldermen said they would move to demand a seat on the Commission itself, instead of being content with an advisory role.

Ottawa was under fire in particular for ignoring the city when the Commission was first established, but Mayor Corbett complained Victoria in his own criticism.

"It is just about time," he fumed, "that both the Dominion and Provincial governments realize that we have a elected body running this city and not just a certain group of citizens."

"I will have more to say about this at a later date," His Worth said.

(When asked later to whom he referred as comprising the "certain group," the mayor said he wasn't ready yet to make a statement. It is known, however, that he resented the omission of a civic representative on the provincial advisory committee on A.R.P.)

In telling council that there are no vacancies on the 36-member board assisting the Security Commission, Austin Taylor added that he has notified the federal department of health that he will be resigning from the board.

The government must have a list of the taxpayers money to throw away," he said.

U.S. May Get Compulsory War Savings

President Roosevelt is working today on a program designed to stop inflation by the most complete control of American economic resources.

High government officials said the plan, in its broad principles, is similar to that in effect in Canada, and would give the government power to control prices, rents, wages and savings. It would freeze wages, control prices and rents in defense areas.

The major problem yet to be solved is the control of excess purchasing power. Present plans are to divert it into savings—either compulsory or voluntary purchase of government bonds.

High government officials said the program would be announced within two weeks.

Some form of voluntary savings to control approximately \$2,000,000,000 of excess purchasing power may be tried. If that fails then compulsory savings would be ordered. It probably would include partial payment of wages, salaries and other income in non-negotiable government bonds.
