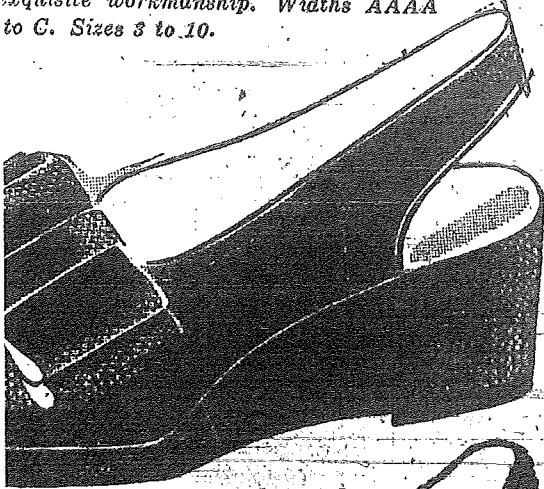

### British Minister Raps Senators' Charges

PORTLAND, Me., Oct. 15.—  
(AP) — Sir Gerald Campbell,  
British minister to the United  
States, said here no real good  
could come from the type of dis-  
closures and attendant publicity  
which marked the recent secret  
Senate sessions at which five  
senators reported on their tour  
of world battle-fronts.

Those senators, Sir Gerald said  
in an interview, should either  
discuss their findings publicly or  
prevent a "leakage of only the  
sensational."

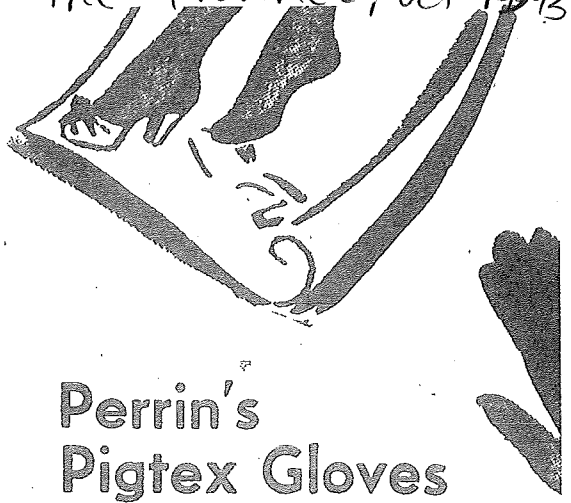
Sir Gerald, who will address  
the Portland Rotary Club, said  
that while it might be too early  
to assess the value of Italy's  
declaration of war against Ger-  
many it should have at least "a  
strong nuisance value to the Ger-  
mans."

### Await Information To Start Jap Suit

Request for action in Ottawa  
on needed information by which  
court procedure can be started  
on legal protest against the com-  
pulsory sale of Japanese prop-  
erty will be made immediately,  
J. A. MacLennan, counsel for the  
Japanese owners, said Thursday.

Three petitions of right, seek-  
ing permission to sue the Fed-  
eral Government were sent to  
Ottawa some months ago, two of  
which were recently approved.  
The petitions were in the names  
of a Japanese national, a natural-  
ized Japanese, and a Canadian-  
born Japanese. No indication,  
however, was given as to which  
two were approved, and thus an  
action could not be started.
