SET FOR.....

1. The above named is at present in custody at the Canadian Immigration Detention Shed, having been arrested as an alien enemy. On Dec. 9th, 1941 the writer interviewed this man at his place of detention in an effort to obtain information as to his assets or otherwise which might prove of value to the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property in the administration of his affairs.

2. At the time of this interview Yanagida, who speaks no English and had to be interviewed with the aid of an interpreter, had no records before him and therefore had to rely upon his memory. He was not able therefore to supply definite information in all cases.

3. Yanagida is a single man, aged 32 years and residing at 391 Powell St. Vancouver, B.C. He is employed as a labourer with Tanaka & Co. at 755 Powell St. He operates bank account Y 1518 with the Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co. on Powell St but his passbook which is among his effects under seizure shows only a balance of a few cents.

4. He appears to have no assets other than his personal effects with the exception of a \$5.00 war savings certificate which he believes to be among the papers seized at the time of his arrest. His father is dead and his mother resides in Japan. He came to Canada in 1935. He acknowledges a debt to his cousin, Mr. & Mrs. Matazo ITONAGA of \$170.

5. Among the personal effects under seizure we have policy No. P-107124 with the Monarch Life Assurance Company for \$1000. 25 year participating endowment with a premium of 40.30 annually.

6. Although the above named states that he has no other assets other than those declared herein it does not necessarily mean that we have all the desired information. An effort will be made to verify this with the cooperation of the local representative of the Custodian for Enemy Alien Property at an early opportunity.

In report from the R.C.M.P., dated Dec. 12, 1941, it is stated that Yanagida acknowledged debt to his cousins, Mr. & Mrs. Matsuo Itonaga of \$170.00. The Itonaga's did not declare that Yanagida was indebted to them, nor was any mention made of this debt on the Statement of Assets and Liabilities prepared by Yanagida at the Internment Camp.

The only asset of this man taken over by the Custodian was 43¢ account in the Japan & Canada Trust Savings.
