On May 22, 1943, however, his account was credited with the sum of \$50.10 as refund of National Defense Tax for 1942. These funds were remitted to him on October 4, 1943.

A camera, surrendered by this man to the RCMP, was released to the B. C. Security Commission on September 14, 1943, for shipment to the owner.
