SET FOR.....

1. The above named is at present in custody in the Canadian Immigration Detention Shed in Vancouver having been arrested as an alien enemy. He is 47 years old and is a casual labourer at present unemployed. He is married but his wife and two children are living in Japan.

2. This man has been interviewed by the writer in an effort to obtain information which might prove of assistance to the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property in the administration of his affairs. Deguchi is apparently in very poor financial circumstances. He has no bank account and lives in Steveston with a friend, Mankichi YOSHIDA, and pays no rent. He acknowledges a debt to his brother, Toyokichi DOMAI of Nanaimo, B.C.

3. Deguchi when arrested had \$93.85 on his person which is now among the effects which are held by the military authorities at his place of detention. He has no life insurance, bonds or other form of assets. He has no car and owns no property.

4. An effort will be made to verify the information contained herein at a later date in cooperation with the local representative of the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property.
