This Internee holds Sun Life Assurance Company Policy No. 2,111,222, being a \$1,000.00, 20 year endowment, dated July 1, 1931. Premium payments on this Policy are considerably in arrears and an amount of \$463.05 is shown under the Automatic Premium Loan Statement, as at July 1, 1945.

Eight \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, in the name of Waichi MURAKAMI, were surrendered for their cash value, and these funds forwarded to the Internee at the Camp.

This Japanese declared 1 Wicker Basket, 1 Suitcase, and 2 Boxes, stored at Port Alberni, B. C. Effects at Port Alberni were sold by auction on January 12, 1944, and this man's account was credited with \$23.53, as a result of sale of his goods.

No other property interests appear on this file.



SET FOR.....

1. The above named is at present in custody at the Canadian Immigration Detention Shed in Vancouver, having been arrested as an alien enemy. He is fifty two years old and is employed as a millworker with the Alberni and Pacific Lumber Co. at Port Alberni. He resides at that point with his wife, Hideo, and two children.

2. This man was interviewed in an effort to obtain information as to his assets which might prove of assistance to the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property in the administration of his affairs.

3. Murakami has a small balance in an account with the Bank of Montreal in Port Alberni. He has no other bank accounts elsewhere. He is behind with his premiums on a \$1000. Sun Life policy which he has had for 12 years. He also has another policy with the Sun Life, (\$2500.) which he has had for eight years.

4. Subject has no investments such as stocks, bonds etc and has about \$20 in war savings certificates in his house. The house, which is the property of the A.&P.Lumber company is rented at \$2.00 per month and the contents in it are worth less than \$100.

5. Two or three months ago Murakami sent \$300. to his sister, Matsuyo Seiyo at Haney, B.C. with which to purchase a piece of land for him. \$250. of this sum was his own money and the other \$50. was the property of Toshiyo TAKESHITA of Port Alberni. Subject also admits a debt of \$40 to Kanjiro TAKEMURA of Port Alberni.

6. An effort will be made at a later date to verify the information contained herein with the cooperation of the local representative of the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property.
