SET FOR.....

1. The above named is at present in custody in Vancouver, B.C. having been arrested on Dec.29th,1941 as an alien enemy by this Force. He was interviewed by the writer in an effort to obtain information as to his assets etc. which might prove of assistance to the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property.
2. Subject is a Japanese National, speaks very little English. He is 36 years old and single. He has been employed as a labourer at the Green Cove Saltery at Green Cove. Tabata has no bank account but has been in the habit of leaving his money with the company and drawing only that which he needed. There is at present between four and five hundred dollars with the company which is the property of this man.
3. Tabata has no other accounts and possesses no investments of any kind except an insurance policy with the Sun Life for \$1000. which he has carried for seven years. He has no car and owns no property or other assets in Canada, the United States or elsewhere. Subject claims to be free from debt. He has no war savings certificates or Victory bonds.
4. An effort will be made at a later date to verify the information contained herein with the local representative of the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property.

Ross & Sons advised that Green Cove Saltaries Limited, with whom Yoshizo Tabata was employed prior to internment, was carrying an account receivable on its books for \$25.70, and wished to know if there were any funds available with the Custodian to settle this claim. On July 4, 1947, the Custodian advised Messrs. P.S. Ross & Sons of TABATA's address and stated that the balance of this ex-Internee's account was remitted to him November 20, 1946.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

The only assets declared to the Custodian by this Internee were a Sun Life Policy for \$1,000.00, and a credit account with the Green Cove Salteries.

On February 12, 1942, the Green Cove Salteries Limited forwarded to this office their cheque, amounting to \$202.39, representing the credit account of this Japanese with their Company. These funds were deposited into the account of Yoshizo TABATA.

Sun Life Assurance Company Policy No. 2,157,847, being a \$1,000.00, 20 year Endowment contract, was forwarded to this Insurance Company for Cash Surrender Value, and on March 25, 1944, this office received their cheque, amounting to \$412.51, in full settlement under this policy contract. Said funds were placed to the credit of this Japanese. *Remittance was made to him at Alcatraz Camp from time to time & final balance remitted to him at Hamilton, Ont, November 20, 1946.*

No property interests, other than those mentioned, appear on this file.
