GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Tomekichi KONDO #02263

April 6, 1949

Neither this man nor his wife reported any property to the Custodian in their original declarations. However on June 25, 1943 he requested shipment of goods left in store of Mrs. T. Watanabe, 627 E. Cordova. All the goods we had in storage that could be identified as his property were shipped to him - Receipt acknowledged by him in letter in which he listed the goods which he had not received.

The goods not received were,

1 dark reddish colored varnished box containing Japanese & Western records  
1 large colored picture 19"x13" showing 2 boys beside toy car with fence in background.  
2 dolls - (1 in pink dress in unvarnished case, 1 in orange in varnished case)  
1 Wooden box 20"x12"x18" containing ricebowl, saucer, etc.

On December 9, 1948 we shipped to Kondo a parcel of framed and loose photos. File does not show whether or not the picture listed above was in this shipment. Mr. Johnstone has been asked to look among unidentified photos for the picture of the 2 boys.

The other items listed probably were sold among the items sold and proceeds credited to Mrs. Tomi Watanabe, File 4834, but there is not sufficient information to enable us to segregate the goods, and all the funds have been sent to Mrs. Watanabe.

The sum of \$5.41 received as refund of 1% wage tax was paid to the Retail Credit Grantors Bureau to apply on a claim of \$36.13 filed on behalf of St. Pauls Hospital. This claim was acknowledged by Kondo.
