RE: Tokutaro SAKAMOTO

The T. B. Division of the Provincial Board of Health, on Sept. 29th, 1942, filed a claim against the above in the sum of \$273.00, for maintenance of his daughter, Shizuke SAKAMOTO, who was a patient in the St. Joseph's Oriental Hospital.

Our efforts to get Mr. SAKAMOTO to admit the claim failed, but from a letter received from Dr. Uchida, dated March 15th, 1943, it would appear that Mr. SAKAMOTO had discussed this account with Dr. Uchida. Dr. Uchida also advised in this letter that at that time Mr. SAKAMOTO was not in a position to meet this claim.

On receipt of this report from Dr. Uchida, the subject was referred back to the Collector of Institutional Revenue on May 27th, 1943, at which time we gave them Mr. SAKAMOTO's address in Slocan.

No useful purpose can be served by pursuing this matter any further.


