LIABILITY SUMMARY

Re: SUZUKI, Shiso - Reg. No. 00958.

The Department of Labour filed a claim against the estate of the wife of the above, Toyo SUZUKI, File 13016, for funeral expenses which amounted to \$80.00. Toyo's account was nil and the claim was placed on the husband's file. His balance amounts to \$39.05 and we have asked the Department of Labour if they wish this amount to be applied against their claim. They advised us that they do not wish his credit to be applied against their claim but ask that the claim be left on the wife's file, in the event that funds be credited to her account.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: SUZUKI, Shuzo - Reg. No. 00958.

Shuzo SUZUKI signed a declaration to the Custodian, to the effect that he had no property, on March 27, 1942 and was evacuated on June 5, 1942.

CHATTELS: In March 1942, he requested Dr. Banno to pick up certain goods left by him at the Crown Hotel, 22 West Cordova, but Dr. Banno was unable to do so, as the goods were reported to have been moved by the Custodian a short time previously. The Crown Hotel was operated by Kanekichi KOSAKA, File Int.1007 and goods belonging to him as well as to Mrs. Kimiyo KUTSUKAKE, File 10005, daughter of SUZUKI and to the SUZUKI's were all stored there.

The Chattels were moved to the Warehouse, at 992 Powell Street, in April 1944 and 1 basket, 1 suitcase, 1 kit bag, all marked SUZUKI, as well as 1 trunk marked K. KOSAKA were shipped to the Japanese on May 23, 1944. SUZUKI wrote on May 27, 1944 acknowledging receipt of the above items and asking for the boxes of silverware, kitchenware etc, which he stated had been left by him. These have been sold by Auction Vancouver 17 and 20 on file Int.1007. The proceeds derived from the sale, credited to Int. 1007 have all been sent to the Internee's wife at his request. File 299 has been credited with a box of tools and a baby buggy. It is doubtful if this baby buggy belongs to SUZUKI but, from information on the Auction File, it seems that it was tagged with his name. Kimiyo KUTSUKAKE, daughter of SUZUKI lived at the same address and was the mother of a young child so that the buggy may belong to her.

Though KOSAKA, Kanekichi did not declare any chattels, it seems obvious that our fieldmen not finding any labels on the chattels at 22 West Cordova took them to belong to the former householder and thus credited the proceeds of their sale. Shuzo SUZUKI has stated that they belong to him and the proceeds having all been disbursed, we are advising him that he must settle directly with KOSAKA.

SPECIFIED

ARTICLES: Shuzo SUZUKI was the owner of a Marconi Combination which was sold for the net sum of \$38.53. The Japanese had lost his receipt and sent us a copy given to him by the R. C. M.P. Office at Greenwood. This is being accepted in lieu of the original.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
