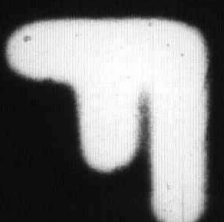
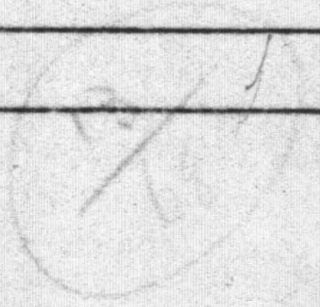

Liabilities: Claim of \$2.80 filed by O. Kondo Co. was denied by Takashima, June 25/43. no further action by Custodian.

All funds credited to the account of this man have been released to him, and his account has been closed.



We were informed by the Office of the Registrar, War Savings Certificates, on December 23rd, that the Internee forwarded seven \$10.00 War Savings Certificates for redemption during the month of September and accordingly on October 9th they forwarded him a cheque for \$56.40 to Unit 3, Taft, B.C. To date this cheque has not been returned to them by the postal authorities.

Attached hereto is our cheque for \$11.00 representing wages owing the Internee for the month of October. Will you kindly place this amount to his credit in the Canteen.
