Dear Madam:

Re: Kenichi NAKAMOTO, Deceased.

Enclosed is Custodian cheque in your favour for the sum of \$12.52. This represents all funds to the credit of your late husband, Kenichi NAKAMOTO, in this office.

The only assets declared to the Custodian by either your husband or yourself were a few personal effects which you left at Prince Rupert. Some of these articles were shipped to you at your request, others were sold at auction for a net amount of \$9.90. A further credit of \$2.62 was derived from a refund of deposit by the Northern B. C. Power Co. Ltd.

Your husband, in his declaration to the Custodian, declared that he owed \$150.00 to Mr. Mochida, Mochida Hotel, Prince Rupert, and \$250.00 to Mr. Yamanaka, a grocer at Prince Rupert. Mr. Yamanaka later filed a claim against your husband for \$428.47. As there were no funds to your husband's credit in this office at that time, the creditors were advised to contact him direct in an endeavour to effect settlement. We have not been advised that these debts have been paid.

The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim against the estate of your husband for the sum of \$80.00 to cover his funeral expenses but, in view of the small credit balance in the account of your late husband, they have withdrawn their claim in order that these funds might be released for your use.

Kindly acknowledge receipt of the enclosed cheque.
