GENERAL SUMMARY

Tajima Abe died in the Revelstoke Hospital on May 18, 1943. According to the information on file, the deceased had no relatives in Canada.

The B. C. Security Commission advised that the effects of the deceased were sold for \$22.00 and the proceeds applied against the claim for funeral expenses. The total expense incurred in connection with the funeral of the deceased was \$86.00 and the total reimbursement from various sources amounted to \$60.03, leaving a balance of \$25.97.

On April 12, 1945, the sum of \$5.00 was credited to the account of the deceased. A cheque for this amount is, today, being forwarded to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, to apply on their claim.
