## Re: Chika ADACHI #06581

In his declaration to the Custodian on March 23, 1942, this man declared \$300.00 worth of furniture.

All this furniture was shipped to Mrs. ADACHI in August, 1942. The fact that shipment was made was confirmed in a letter September 23, 1942, received from Hiroshi ADACHI, file 362, son of Chika ADACHI. At that time Hiroshi ADACHI reported that a bag of kitchenware and a trunk was in the care of Mrs. Jim Glillaspik at 7225 Blenheim St., Vancouver, and that they intended to have these goods sent later on. We have heard nothing further from the ADACHI family in regard to these items and it is possible that the goods were shipped to them. At any rate in July, 1943, no Japanese effects were found at 7225 Blenheim St.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$7.31 received from the Provincial Government as refund of 1% wage deductions for 1941. This sum was remitted to him November 13, 1942.

He declared two \$100.00 Victory Bonds in his own possession and \$120.00 in War Saving Certificates. These did not come under the control of this office.

He declared a bank account with the Bank of Montreal and another account with the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Co. The first did not come under the control of this office and the list of depositors of the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Co. as at December 31,1942 does not give the name of this man. It would therefore appear that all funds must have been withdrawn from his account prior to that time.

Two life insurance policies were declared, Sun Life Assurance Co. policy #464758 for \$1000.00. On December 1, 1944, we received a cheque for \$1007.47 representing the maturity value of this policy. This cheque was forwarded to Mr. ADACHI on December 5, 1944. And a Monarch Life policy No. P.104181 for \$1000.00. The file reveals nothing further in connection with this second policy. These items did not come under the control of the Custodian.

On February 4 we received from the London & Scottish Assurance Corporation a cheque for \$286.16 payable to Hiroshi ADACHI and Chika ADACHI, representing the cash surrender value of the former's life insurance policy. This cheque was sent to Hiroshi ADACHI on February 4, 1944.

On November 20, 1945, Chika ADACHI filed a claim for \$150.00 against Kiyoshi SHINMOTO, file 13932, and Mrs. SHINMOTO, file 593, wife of Kiyoshi SHINMOTO, authorated payment of this sum to ADACHI. At that time all the funds belonging to Mr. and Mrs. SHINMOTO were credited to the account of Mrs. SHINMOTO. On February 5, 1946, however, we transferred all funds except those received from the sale of household effects to a joint account in the names of Mr. and Mrs. SHINMOTO, and from this joint account we transferred the sum of \$150.00 to the account of Chika ADACHI in settlement of his claim.

This file reveals no further property of any kind.
