Re: Mr. Hiroshi ADACHI, Reg. No. 11246

In his declaration to the Custodian, signed March 24, 1942, this man declared a quantity of household effects belonging to his father, which was being held by the present tenant at his former premises.

All these household effects were shipped to him, receipt for which we received in a letter dated September 23, 1942. At that time he notified us that 2 pieces of effects belonging to him were held at the home of Mrs. Jim Gillespie at 7225 Blenheim St., Vancouver. We have had considerable trouble with this woman and on inspecting the premises on July 5, 1943, after Mrs. Gillespie had moved out, no Japanese effects were found on the premises. In the absence of evidence, to the contrary, it is being assumed that the effects had been shipped to ADACHI.

One \$50.00 Victory Bond, one \$100.00 Victory Bond and \$90.00 in War Saving Certificates were declared by ADACHI in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

In his declaration Mr. ADACHI declared \$349.00 to his credit in the Bank of Montreal, and \$120.00 to his credit in the Canadian Bank of Commerce. This did not come under the control of this office.

This man declared a balance of \$17.00 to his credit with the Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co. As the name of this man does not appear on the list of depositors of this company as at December 31, 1942, it is assumed that the funds held to his credit had been withdrawn prior to that date.

This man declared an insurance policy in the amount of \$3,500.00 with the London & Scottish Assurance Corporation. In November, 1943, he surrendered his policy for cash and on February 4, 1944, a cheque for \$286.16 was sent to ADACHI. This did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no further property of any kind.
