## Re: Tomeziro ASAI -- Reg. No. 04494

This man registered with the Custodian on March 30th, 1942, at which time he declared kitchen utensils, one bed, one trunk stored at P. O. Box 223, Steveston. This address was not sufficient for us to locate the premises and on referring further to the Japanese, we were advised that the house was beside the hotel in Steveston. Our investigator wrote that the house next to the hotel was the Commercial Hotel which was demolished by orders from the Fire Marshal. There were no chattels in the house at the time of its demolition.

It must, therefore, be assumed that these things were stolen and as there are no claims against this man, the file may be closed.

I certify this to be a true statement of affairs as disclosed by this file.
