
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

GENERAL SUMMARY

April 6, 1949

File 384 Yasuko ASANO, Reg.No. 01455

JP - March 28, 1942 Evacuation - September 2, 1942 Repatriation - October 2/46

Mrs. Asano declared a fairly large quantity of household and personal effects which she valued at \$400.00. She did not state where these were left. Her husband (Rokujiro, File 13935) declared an almost similar list of goods left at 343 West 5th Ave, Vancouver, in a JP which he signed on April 14, 1943. On February 8, 1944, we wrote Mr. Rokujiro Asano and told him that our investigators had been informed that he had removed or sold his chattels prior to his evacuation, and we asked, if this information was incorrect, to let us know. No reply was received from Mr. Asano, and no further action was taken in regard to the goods.

Mrs. Asano reported Prudential Life Insurance Co. policy. August 10, 1946, 9 cheques totaling \$221.05 were received representing cash surrender value of insurance policies of the Asano family. \$100.00 was sent to the Asanos before their repatriation. The balance was handed to the Treasury Dept.

There is no record of payment of any of the debts reported by Mrs. Asano. List is shown on orange sheet.
