Dear Sir:

This is to advise that your camera was forwarded to you on the first of November by insured parcel post. Mailing costs of 30 cents, being postage of 25 cents and packing costs of 5 cents, were charged to your account with this office.

The radio which you surrendered to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police was sold, as you have already been advised, and the net proceeds of \$11.90 were credited to your account.

On December 12, 1942, we remitted to you Custodian cheque for the sum of \$12.15. This represented the redemption value of three \$5.00 War Savings Certificates which you had sent to this office to be redeemed.

A refund of one per cent wage tax for the period January to June, 1941, was obtained by this office on your behalf, and cheque for \$2.39, the amount of the refund, was sent to you on August 24, 1943.

Your Prudential Life Policy M5357709 for the amount of \$500.00 was received in this office for safe-keeping in October, 1942. This policy was returned to you on June 19, 1943.

Custodian cheque for the sum of \$11.60 is enclosed herewith. This represents the net proceeds from the sale of your radio, less mailing charges on your camera. No funds remain to your credit with this office.

It would appear that we have accounted for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, and acknowledge receipt of your camera and the enclosed cheque, we are attaching a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Kiyoshi James MAEDA, Reg. No. 07995

This man stated in his declaration to the Custodian, on April 7, 1942, that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area. He was interned on May 16, 1942, and on May 29, 1942, he stated that his life insurance was the only property owned. His file reveals the following personal property:

Specified Articles: The radio described in Specified Articles Memorandum was sold and the net proceeds of \$11.90 credited to his account.

The camera described in Specified Articles Memorandum was mailed to Kiyoshi MAEDA on November 1, 1945.

Securities: War Savings Certificates, 3 of \$5.00 each, were redeemed through this office, and the sum of \$12.15, received from the Registrar of War Savings Certificates December 18, 1942, was credited to his account, and on December 12, 1942, this sum was remitted to him at Angler Internment Camp. As he had been released at the time the funds reached the camp, this cheque was forwarded to him by the camp officials.

Accounts Receivable: Refund of 1% Income Tax, Jan. to June 1941, was received from the Commissioner of Income Tax, Vancouver. This (\$2.39) sum was remitted to Kiyoshi MAEDA on August 24, 1943.

Life Insurance: Prudential Life Policy M5357709 for the amount of \$500.00 was received in this office for safe-keeping on October 21, 1942. This policy was returned to Kiyoshi MAEDA on June 19, 1943, and receipt acknowledged by him June 29, 1943. No premiums were paid through this office. This did not vest in the Custodian.

This file reveals no other personal property of any kind.


