



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Hichizo ISHIKAWA
Registration No. 03369

Hichizo ISHIKAWA, XI 387, was interned on March 12, 1942. The RCMP report on this internee reads: "He further stated that his assets consist of a life insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada, and small accounts in the Bank of Montreal, Main and Hastings Branch, Japan and Canada Trust & Savings, and the Royal Bank of Canada, Steveston."

On April 1942, Hichizo ISHIKAWA made out a statement of his assets and liabilities for the Custodian. This declaration contained the following information:

Insurance Premiums paid on Canada Sun Life Policy for \$1000.00, Estimated	\$700.00

Bank Accounts: On March 7, 1942, the Custodian wrote to these three Banks and on March 9, 1942 received the following information:
The Royal Bank at Steveston reported that ISHIKAWA had no account with this bank,
The Bank of Montreal, Main & Hastings Branch, reported a \$1.10 credit. This amount was transferred to this office on June 5, 1942 for deposit to the account of Hichizo ISHIKAWA
On March 10, 1942, the Japan & Canada Trust Savings reported a current account of \$3.61 and a Savings account of \$2.17 with them. These funds were later transferred to this office for credit to Ishikawa's account.

When informed that the Royal Bank of Canada, at Steveston had reported no account in his name, Hichizo ISHIKAWA informed the Camp Commandant at Petawawa Internment Camp that he was certain he had an account with the bank amounting to between \$2.00 and \$5.00. On June 23rd, 1942, this office wrote stating that it seemed doubtful that ISHIKAWA had ever had a bank account at Steveston.

Life Insurance: The life insurance policy held by ISHIKAWA was a \$1000.00, 20 year Endowment Policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada, Policy #821,154. The beneficiary was his brother, Junya ISHIKAWA.

On October 31st, 1942, with the agreement of Hichizo ISHIKAWA, this office forwarded \$6.88, the balance of ISHIKAWA's account in this office as part payment of the premium for 1942 owing on his policy.

On June 4, 1946 ISHIKAWA requested the cash surrender value of his policy. On Sept. 11, 1946 a cheque for \$803.94, the cash surrender value of this policy was forwarded to this office. This money was credited to ISHIKAWA's account in this office.

War Savings Certificates:

In his statement of April 1, 1942, above Hichizo ISHIKAWA also reported that he owned 2 War Saving Certificates. As ISHIKAWA was interned, these certificates fell under the control of the Custodian, so on May 12, 1942, War Saving Certificates, Nos. TA1574905-6 were forwarded to this office. These were redeemed on July 8, 1946, and the funds arising were deposited to the account of the above-named internee.

On January 29, 1947, a cheque in the amount of \$812.70 was forwarded to the Supervising Treasury office on account of the above-mentioned internee, thereby closing his account with this office. Hichizo ISHIKAWA was repatriated on the S S. General Meigs, on the 17th June, 1946.

There is no other property of any kind revealed on this file.
