1. With reference to the above and further to report submitted by the writer on March 10th., 1942, the writer made another patrol to the home of the above captionally noted subject, accompanied by S/Const. D. Couper, in an effort to locate the life insurance policy for \$1000.00 mentioned in letter from the Custodian of Enemy Alien Property (Japanese) under date of March 7th., 1942.

2. YASHIKI'S Father was questioned by S/Const. Couper and a complete search was made of the house for the policy, but no trace of it could be found. The father saying he knew nothing about it. However, during the search a number of War Savings Certificates were found, these being in the name of Jwi YASHIKI and upon questioning the father again, it was learned that these belonged to his son, Joji, so they were placed under seizure by the writer. The following is a list showing the serial nos. and face value of each.

1. Acting on instructions of Sgt. J.K. Barnes, i/c Intelligence Section, on the 2nd instant the captionally named Japanese National was taken into custody under authority of the Defence of Canada Regulations.
2. On the 3rd instant this prisoner was handed over to the Military Detail at the Immigration Detention Shed for internment, a receipt being taken for his living body and effects, which is held on file at this point.
3. Certificate of Parole No. 151280 was surrendered for cancellation.
4. This prisoner stated that he is single but is the sole support of his father, Wakamatsu Kashiki R.R. #2, Eburne, B.C.
5. He further stated that his assets consist of a \$1000 Life Insurance policy with the Manufacturers' Life Insurance Co., an account in the East End Branch of the Royal Bank of Canada of about \$20.00, a 1929 Chevrolet Sedan and a 1935 International 1½-2 ton truck. These assets are now in his father's possession. Subject also had in his possession a \$50 War Savings Certificate, # H444967.

1. With reference to the above and in compliance with request contained in letter from the Office of the Custodian, dated at Vancouver, B.C., on March 7th., 1942, the writer, accompanied by Const. Robson, H.E. and Const. Hadfield, made a patrol to the home of the above captionally noted subject and the two vehicles in question placed under seizure. It was not possible at this time to take possession of the Life Insurance Policy for \$1000.00 as YASHIKI'S mother did not speak sufficient English to understand. A patrol will be made at a future date with S/Cst. G. Upton to act as interpreter at which time the policy will be seized.

2. The 1929 Chevrolet sedan and the 1935 International truck were not in particularly good condition and it necessitated the purchase of gasoline by the writer to get the Chevrolet into town. Same were brought in, however, and turned over to Madill's Garage and receipts obtained for same.

3. Receipts for 1929 Chevrolet Sedan B.C. License # 92-516, year 1941, and 1935 International truck, B.C. License # 04348, year 1941, are attached hereto.

Chattels: In his report to the R.C.M.P., the above noted Internee stated he owned a 1929 Chevrolet Sedan and a 1935 International 1½-2 ton truck. These two cars were sold by the Custodian at a total net price of \$500.58, and proceeds credited to the account of this Internee.

Certain chattels, bearing the name of the above named, were sold at Custodian Auction, Steveston, on June 29, 1945, and the net proceeds, namely \$15.15, were placed to the credit of the Internee's account with the Custodian.

Securities Eleven (11) \$5.00 War Savings Certificates and one (1) \$50.00 Victory Bond, owned by the above noted, are presently held in safe-keeping by the Custodian. *These were sent to the insurance through the Royal Bank of Canada by this office on Aug. 16, 1947. - B.M.*

This Internee held several small bank accounts, totalling approximately \$24.81, and these balances were transferred to this office and placed to the Internee's credit.

Life Insurance Joju YASHIKI holds Policy No. 652,834, with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company. This Policy is a \$1,000.00, 25 year endowment, and premiums amount to \$38.55 annually. Premium due November, 1945, has been paid and policy is in good standing. *On Oct. 26, 1946 a cheque for \$35.50 in payment of the premium due Nov. 1, 1946 was sent to the insurance Co. B. Mac A. Hill*

No property interests, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.


