Dear Sir:

As requested, we enclose herewith the sum of \$144.54, representing all funds standing to your credit with this office.

In your declaration to the Custodian, on March 21, 1942, you reported ownership of a fishing vessel. This vessel, the "I.D.", New Westminster 3241, was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, for the total sum of \$431.00. The Committee's supervision costs of \$6.81 were deducted from the sale price, and the balance, in the amount of \$424.19, was paid in to this office on your behalf. From this sum remittances to the amount of \$290.00 were sent to you from time to time, leaving to your credit a balance of \$134.19 from your boat money.

The Dominion Government paid in to this office the sum of \$10.35, in settlement of your claim for refund of expenses incurred at the time you brought your vessel to Steveston and surrendered her to Naval Service.

The enclosed cheque for \$144.54, therefore represents the balance of your boat money and the refund of \$10.35.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the enclosed cheque, we are attaching a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 394 Re: Iwao DOMAE

Reg. No. 07939

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 21, 1942. He was interned on April 21, 1942.

The only property declared was his fishing vessel. This vessel was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$424.19. This sum was paid in to this office and credited to Iwao DOMAE's account as, at the time of sale, he was in Internment Camp. Complete details in regard to this vessel are given on the Vessels Summary.

The sum of \$10.35 was received from the Dominion Government, being refund of expenses incurred by Iwao DOMAE in returning to Nanaimo after bringing his fishing vessel to the Fraser River at the time the vessel was impounded.

This file reveals no real property interest. No liabilities are shown on this file. The only assets of any kind shown in this file are the fishing vessel and the refund received from the Dominion Government.

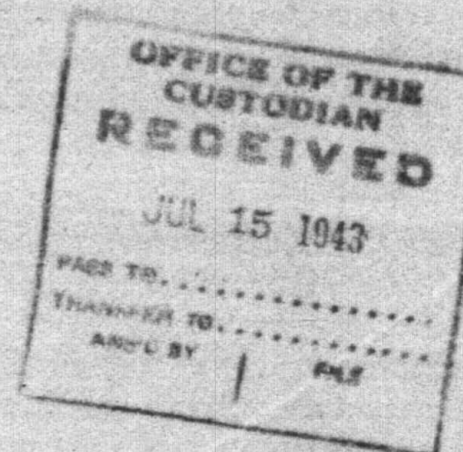


