GENERAL SUMMARY

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 25, 1942. He was evacuated on April 15, 1942.

In his declaration he stated that he owned no property of any kind left in the protected area.

There is no evidence on his file of any real property interest, and no claims have been filed against him.

According to the records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, Masao IKEBATA sold the vessel "M.I." NW.1840, on March 24, 1942, and the net proceeds of this sale, \$559.48, were paid to him direct on March 26, 1942. Details are given in the Vessels Summary.

Claim of Masao IKEBATA for refund of expenses incurred in taking his vessel to the impounding area at Prince Rupert was settled by the Dominion Government for the sum of \$5.00, which was paid to this office and credited to his account.

Notice from the Bank of Montreal, Prince Rupert, was received in this office on November 16, 1945. This notice dealt with account #4602, and has been forwarded to Masao IKEBATA.

This file reveals no other assets of any kind whatsoever.
