



November, 1942, Hideji Ezaki asked shipment of goods left in care of Sisters of The Atonement, 385 Cordova E. The Sisters reported holding one box and permission to ship was given December 14, 1942.

Jan. 31, 1944 one box was received from North Pacific Cannery in name of H. Ezaki. There is no record of the disposition of this box on this file, nor on File 2218, which is the file of the only other H. Ezaki in our records.

/FM The only other property reported on this file is \$231.95 in bank account. This was not brought under Custodian control.


