The B. C. Purchasers' Association filed claim of \$14.91 against this man. A counter claim was reported by Iwasa. See letter of February 4, 1944. No further action by Custodian.

Dear Sir:

Re: Kihachi IWASA

Your letter of April 14th, in connection
with the above named is received.

When I wrote to you on April 1st, giving
you details of this man's assets, subject had been appre-
hended and was then held in custody by the local Military
Authorities on our behalf at the Immigration Detention
Shed in Vancouver. These detenus are sent from the
receiving station in Vancouver to Internment Camps through-
out the country, at the discretion of the Director of
Internment Operations. I am unable to tell you at the
present time where this particular man is. He may still
be in Vancouver, under Military Guard, of course, or he
may have been transferred to an established Internment
Camp.

Once we hand these men over to the Military
Authorities, we have no further control over them; thus I
am unable to tell you at this particular time where subject
is being held. It is likely that the local Military Authori-
ties here would be able to supply you with this information.

"Further to our letter of July 6th, we beg to advise you in regard to the claim made by the B. C. Purchasers Co-operative Association, amounting to \$14.91, against the above Internee, that we have received the following statement in regard to which we would be pleased to have your comments.

'Further to my statement on your enquiry in connection with the claim made against me from the B. C. Purchasers Association in Vancouver, B. C., I would like to state that I had a letter from my wife on this matter, and found that I not only have any debt from the Association but I have an account amounting to over fifty-four dollars (\$54.00) to be received from the Association.

She states that she has written statement issued by the association, however she did not mention an exact amount, just stated over fifty-four dollars.

Kindly therefore, arrange with the Association to collect the account they are owing, then credit that to my account in your office. When collected I wish you will let me know'."

We would be pleased to have your reply in this connection as soon as possible.

Dear Sir: re Iwasa Mihachi and B. C. Purchasers'
Co-operative Association.

We regret that we overlooked replying to your letter of August 28th last in this connection.

It appears that this is another situation whereby Iwasa claims to have a set-off against the B.C. Purchasers' Co-operative Association by virtue of shares held by him and transferred to the Association. There seems no doubt that the Co-operative Association has a claim amounting to \$14.91 against this man, but whether he is entitled to a set-off for shares is a question which we cannot answer at the moment, but that answer must, as far as we can see, await the termination of the war, when the officers of these Associations can be brought together to iron out the differences which are being brought to light.

HEADQUARTERS

1. Acting on instructions of Supt. E.C.P. Salt, Officer i/c Japanese Registration, Vancouver, B.C., the above captionally-noted subject was taken into custody under authority of the Defence of Canada Regulations and escorted to the Immigration Sheds to be held by the Military Authorities for safe-keeping pending internment. Receipt was obtained for his living body and personal effects and is being held on file at this office.

SUB-DIVISION

2. IWASA gave his dependents as his wife and three children aged 7, 9 and 11 years. He has no assets with the exception of a life insurance policy for \$1000.00 with the Sun Life Insurance Co., and a \$50.00 Dominion of Canada Victory Loan Bond in the name of his child, Masako. He has no property, but his wife has a grocery store at 300 Dunsmuir St.
