PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 414

February 8th, 1946.

Mr. Itsuki FUJINO, Reg. No. 07082

In his declaration of March 30, 1942 this man declared the contents of a four room house, including a bicycle, carpenter's tools and a sewing machine. The bicycle and sewing machine apparently were disposed of by this man prior to December, 1942, as he signed the list of articles stored at 992 Powell Street as being all the chattels remaining in the protected area at that date. Among the chattels stored at 992 Powell Street the following are unaccounted for:

2 counters,
5 kitchen chairs
a roll of linoleum
a steel shaft

The counters and roll of linoleum, in all probability were discarded as valueless. A large quantity of the chattels declared by this man were released to his wife from 992 Powell Street. Some of the articles declared by this man were sold at auction on May 31, 1944, for the net sum of \$9.28 which sum has been credited to the account of his wife, File No. 8412. The wardrobe trunk was stored at 992 Powell Street on May 31, 1944.

He declared a Victory Bond valued at \$60.00 in his own possession and a Sun Life Assurance Company Policy No. 2199547 in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

His account has been credited with the sum of \$14.45 in full settlement of the claim filed by him with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred in connection with the impounding of the Vessel "I.F."

The Vessel "I.F." was known as "K.F." and "Miss Florida" and was sold by Itsuki FUJINO through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee. Although we have no record to show that FUJINO was the licensed owner of this vessel, he must have produced acceptable proof of his ownership at the time of the sale of his Vessel through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee. The net proceeds from the sale in the amount of \$445.50, were paid direct to Itsuki FUJINO on March 25, 1942.

This vessel was also reported under the names "I.F." and "K.F." She was sold under Licence Prince Rupert 1677, but this was probably a mistake, as it seems too high a number. She was reported under the name "K.F" and Licence Vancouver 1677, with Kazumoto FUJINO as owner. Kazumoto FUJINO is not registered with the Custodian, and Vancouver 1677 is not a Japanese-owned vessel. Kasumoto FUJINO's address was given as Steveston. Itsuke FUJINO lived at Deep Bay.

Dear Sir and Madam:

Your files with this office have been reviewed, and it is noted that, in your declarations to the Custodian, you reported ownership of a quantity of furniture and other personal effects. The greater part of these chattels were released to Mrs. FUJINO before she left the protected area. A wardrobe trunk identified as your property is in storage here. The saleable articles remaining were sold at auction for the net sum of \$9.28, which has been credited to your account.

The sum of \$14.45 has been credited to the account of Mr. FUJINO in full settlement of the claim filed by him with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of the vessel "I.F."

The vessel "I.F.", also known as the "K.F." and "Miss Florida" was sold by Mr. FUJINO through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee and the net proceeds of \$445.50 was paid to him on March 25, 1942.

The Victory Bond and Life Insurance Policy declared by Mr. FUJINO did not come under the control of this office.

Your files show that you are indebted to Matsujiro UHASHI, of Port Essington, for the sum of \$500.00. We have no record that this debt has been paid, and therefore are unable to remit to you the funds standing to your credit with this office.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area, which vested in the Custodian, and, in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
