GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Tomitiro TSUJI, Registration No. 06302

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 30, 1942, in which he reported that he owned no property of any kind.

He signed a second declaration to the Custodian on April 3, 1942, in which he reported a boat in custody at New Westminster. This is shown on the Vessel Summary as having been sold for \$25.00, which money was paid to the Harbour Boatyards Ltd. to help satisfy a claim against this boat.

In his declaration he reported that Mr. Moromoto of Marpole, B.C. owed him \$200.00. This was apparently an error as a letter on June 18, 1943 it was reported that he owned this amount to Mr. Moromoto.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

The boat was old and in poor condition, the engine was disconnected.

The Harbour Boatyards Ltd. filed a claim for \$66.25, being 10 month's wharfage at \$2.75, plus \$38.75 for bailing out the boat, etc. This claim was settled for \$33.15

Additional Information: This boat was not turned over to Naval Service, but in July, 1942, the owner started to row her from Balcarra Park to the Harbour Boatyards Ltd. This was reported by B.C. Police to Naval Service. Naval Service pumped out the boat, which had sank, and towed her to the Harbour Boatyards Ltd, at the owner's request. The boats, at this time were being transferred to the Custodian, and this, and the impossibility of taking this boat to New Westminster, was the reason she was not taken into custody. An offer of \$100.00, approximately, was made but was refused by the owner.


