



CHATELS:

Sute FUJIWARA declared that she left her effects at 1031 Royal Avenue, New Westminster, B. C. The file reveals that these were removed to storage at 815 Agnes St., New Westminster and were later sold at Custodian auction sales. The file also reveals that Fumi FUJIWARA, File 7874 left her effects with Sute FUJIWARA, her mother-in-law but they could not be identified. The two parties were asked to arrange their respective interests between themselves. Mrs. Sute FUJIWARA however died on December 24th, 1945 and Koichi FUJIWARA signed a Certificate dated April 23rd, 1946 to the effect that all the chattels declared by Sute FUJIWARA were his and the balance of sales proceeds credited to this account are now being transferred to file 13706. Mrs. Sute FUJIWARA asked for shipment of a sewing machine which was not found, she appeared to be confused as to where she left it.

Sute FUJIWARA declared she and her husband Tomejiro FUJIWARA had equal shares in a \$50.00 Victory Bond #K8 H11338 which they intended to sell.





CHATEL SUMMARY

September 19th, 1946.

Rei Sute (Mrs. Tomotaro) FUJIWARA, Reg. 03080.

The above Japanese person made her declaration to the Custodian on March 28th, 1942 and was evacuated on May 13th, 1942.

This Japanese person declared her personal property on a statement attached to the J. P. form. As she was evacuated some time after she made her declaration the list may not be quite authentic.

On September 19th, 1942, our agents removed the chattels found at 1031 Royal Avenue and stored them at 815 Agnes Street, New Westminster, B.C. lists of these are on the file.

Fumi FUJIWARA, File 7874 declared that she left her effects with "parents in law" at 1031 Royal Avenue, although, she stated she would like to take some of these things with her. This may be confirmed by a memo on the file under date of February 23rd, 1943 which states that the effects were moved with Sute FUJIWARA'S to storage.

There is no evidence on the latter file however, that this was a fact and no identification as to Fumi FUJIWARA'S goods has been established yet. On February 10th, 1943 Sute FUJIWARA admitted she had sold carpets, and chairs subsequent to her declaration.

On July 19th, 1943, Sute FUJIWARA requested shipment to her of a sewing machine. This could not be found amongst the stored goods and there is no evidence on file that one was moved to storage. It may be that the sewing machine Sute FUJIWARA declared was the same one that her daughter-in-law Fumi FUJIWARA stated that she would "like to take with her."

A memo of November 9th, 1943 states the machine may be found at the Buddhist Temple, 120 - 10th Avenue, New Westminster, but none of Sute FUJIWARA'S effects were stored there.

She applied again for this machine on November 8th, 1943 and in addition two boxes of chinaware etc. and wedding pictures. The latter, with the exception of the wedding pictures which were stored, were not shipped as they had been sold in the meanwhile.


Under date of March 17th, 1944, the B.C. Security Commission advised that the sewing machine had not been left in New Westminster but that Mrs. FUJIWARA claimed it was left at the Fuji Chop Suay House, 314 Powell Street, Vancouver, B.C. There is no evidence on the file of this concern, that the machine was even there.

The effects stored at 815 Agnes Street were removed to our auction rooms and sold in sales of November 17th, 1943, November 26th, 1943, December 10th, 1943, May 17th, 1944, August 30th, 1944, October 27th, 1944 March 14th, 1945 and April 12th, 1945. The total net proceeds - \$106.65 being credited to this account.

A heater in storage was missing. Two mattresses and certain home-made goods were unsaleable and were abandoned.

Mrs. Sute FUJIWARA died on December 24th, 1945, and as the result of considerable correspondence with her son, Koichi (file 13706), and the Department of Labour, Koichi FUJIWARA signed a certificate dated April 23rd, 1946, to the effect that the chattels left at 1031 Royal Avenue, New Westminster, were his possessions. This was witnessed by his wife Fumi FUJIWARA and his father Tomijiro FUJIWARA. The Department of Labour by phone on September 16th, 1946, stated that they are agreeable to Koichi FUJIWARA receiving the proceeds of chattel liquidation.
