

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 1, 1942, in which he stated that he owned no property in the protected area.

He was interned on April 21, 1942. At the time of his internment a \$5.00 War Saving Certificate found in his possession was turned over to the Custodian for safe-keeping. This will be returned to him within a few days. *mailed Feb 14/47*

Following internment HAMA reported the following assets: \$18.00 cash in his possession. On May 11, 1942, he reported that he had \$16.00 with the Camp Baymaster; personal effects valued at \$500.00, in his mother's possession. He later stated that he understood all his personal effects were in his mother's possession at Greenwood. None of these assets were brought under the control of the Custodian.

This man reported a Sun Life policy #2210953. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

On July 5, 1943, the sum of \$15.00 was received from B. C. Packers Ltd., Mill Bay Cannery, to cover the purchase price of a net bought from Hideo HAMA. This sum was credited to his account.
