PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. Int.426

December 7, 1946.

Re: Ichizi MIYASHITA, Reg. No.12130

This man was interned on April 21, 1942. He was released from Internment between March 13 and March 14, 1946.

On March 31, 1942, MIYASHITA signed a declaration to the Custodian.

In his declaration and in the Statement of Assets and Liabilities signed after his internment, MIYASHITA reported ownership of a fishing vessel, which he valued at \$1,500.00. The vessel "Lucky Shot" New Westminster Lic. No. 1328, licensed in the name of Ichiji MIYASHITA was sold on December 18, 1942, by the Custodian for the net sum of \$322.43, which was credited to the account of this man.

MIYASHITA declared a row-boat valued at \$15.00 left in the care of Toichi NITSUI, Evac. File 1456. No row-boat identified as property of MIYASHITA found.

MIYASHITA declared a gurdy valued at \$200.00 left in the care of Yoshikazu KAWAGUCHI, Evac. File 1732. Several gurdies found on the property of KAWAGUCHI were delivered to John Ostrom Machine Shop, Bamfield, and later turned over to Naval Service, according to the report of Mr. H.G.Hinton, dated June 16, 1942, on File 173.

MIYASHITA declared a Dominion Life Policy #123,321, for \$1,000.00. The beneficiary of this policy is Tatsuzo MIYASHITA, his father, a resident of Japan. On June 4, 1946, at MIYASHITA's request, we paid the sum of \$275.36 to the Dominion Life Assurance Company, from funds in MIYASHITA's account. This covered all premiums due under this policy up to January 7, 1947. MIYASHITA is now requesting the cash surrender value of this policy. On November 20, 1946, the Dominion Life Assurance Company was informed that the Custodian had no objection to payment being made to MIYASHITA, but were advised to refer the matter to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division.

MIYASHITA was in possession of two \$10.00 War Savings Certificates at the time of his internment. These are now in Custodian Safety Deposit Box.

Sent for redemption Dec 21/46

The account of Ichizi was credited with the sum of \$479.27 as his share of the distribution of the proceeds from the sale of the vessels "Loyal 1" and "Loyal 2", which had been owned by the Ucluelet Fishermen's Co-operative Ass'n. The net proceeds from this sale were distributed among the 51 shareholders. The shares of the Evacuee shareholders were turned over to Messrs. Norris & McBeannan, who acted on behalf of the Association. The shares of Internees were credited to the individual accounts with this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$8.55 received from the B. C. Security Commission as refund of fares and other charges incurred by him at the time of his evacuation. This was credited to his account September 1, 1943

The account of this man was credited with \$12.25, on April 10, 1945, in full settlement of the claim lodged with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of the vessel "Lucky Shot".

It was reported that Isamu TAMAI, Internee, was indebted to Ichizi MIYASHITA in the amount of \$300.00, but MIYASHITA informed this office on July 3, 1942, that this had been settled.

This man had built and occupied a house on land owned by the Bamfield-Nootka Packing Company. By agreement between the landowner and MIYASHITA under which the building had been placed on this land, the building reverted to the landowner when it was vacated by MIYASHITA.

Remittances totalling \$350.00 were made to MIYASHITA from his funds in the period from March 29, 1943 to July 23, 1945. On November 12, 1946, a remittance of \$100.00 was made to MIYASHITA. This last remittance reduced his credit balance to \$97.14. A statement of his account is filed under date of June 19, 1946.

This file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.

Enclosed is Custodian cheque for the sum of \$47.14, representing all the funds standing to your credit with this office.

The sum of \$50.00 has been paid to M. Furuya Company in connection with the claim of \$72.72 filed against you.

Your file shows that the vessel "Lucky Shot" licensed in your name was sold for the net sum of \$322.43, which was credited to your account with this office.

Your account was credited with the sum of \$479.27 as your share of the distribution of the net proceeds of the sale of the vessels "Loyal 1" and "Loyal 2", owned by the Ucluelet Fishermen's Co-operative Association.

Your account was credited with the sum of \$8.55 received from the B. C. Security Commission as refund of expenses incurred by you at the time of your evacuation.

Your account was credited with the sum of \$12.25 in full settlement of the claim lodged with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of the vessel "Lucky Shot".

From your account remittances totalling \$450.00 were made to you in the period from March 29, 1943 to November 12, 1946. On June 4, 1946, payment of \$275.36 was made to the Dominion Life Assurance Company from your funds, being payment of premiums up to January 7, 1947.

On November 20, 1946 this office informed the Dominion Life Assurance Company that the Custodian had no objection to payment to you of the cash surrender value of your Dominion Life policy #123,321.

Two \$10.00 War Savings Certificates, which were in your possession at the time of your internment are in Custodian safety deposit box.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind, left by you in the protected area, which came under the control of the Custodian. In order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the enclosed cheque a stamped, addressed envelope is enclosed.
