1. M. Ebisuzaki Co. Ltd. \$1.65 - Paid on May 26, 1943 from funds remitted by FUKUMOTO for this purpose.
2. W. F. Quarrie & Co. Ltd. - \$29.60 - This claim was acknowledged by FUKUMOTO, who stated that he was unable to settle but would settle the debt when he was in a better financial position. This information and the address of the debtor were supplied to W. F. Quarrie & Co. Ltd. in June and May, 1943. No further action was taken by this office.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Shoichi FUKUMOTO, Reg.No.09083

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 27, 1942.

In his declaration he reported furnishings for a 3 room house and a box of tools. On October 6, 1942, we received from FUKUMOTO an acknowledgment that the goods received into storage at 992 Bwell Street from Woodfibre represented all the chattels belonging to him left in the protected area. The tool box does not appear to be on this list, and presumably it must have been shipped to him from Woodfibre either before or after his evacuation. The camp stove and stove listed were shipped to FUKUMOTO in November and October, 1942. Three bedframes and 4 springs were shown on the list, but only one bed was sold, at the time the remainder of his chattels were disposed of by auction. It is assumed that the 2 beds and 3 springs unaccounted for were found to be unsealable and were discarded. The net proceeds from the sale of his chattels amounted to \$14.50, which has been credited to his account.

He declared \$100.00 in War Savings Certificates in his possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

No other property is revealed by this file.

These files may now be regarded as closed. Together with all other effects at Woodfibre these Japanese' belongings were shipped to storage in Vancouver and a list signed on September 1st by the husband confirms that everything belonging to him in the restricted area is in storage at 992 Powell Street.

The wife declared nothing but on August 28th applied for shipment of a stove. The application is signed S. Fukumoto but bears her registration number. A copy appears on both files and shipment of this stove in two pieces was made as per memorandum of November 26th on file 430. The list dated September 1st on the same file is, therefore, correct except for items 4 and 5 being those shipped.
