Tomekusa IDESHIMA died at Slocan, B. C. on December 13, 1944. He is survived by five daughters, Chiyoko Deshire (file #11585), Fumiko Deshire (file #11586), Tamako Deshire (file #11588), Itoko Deshire (file #11587) and Mrs. Tomiko Aoyama (file #11217). The names DESHIMA and IDESHIMA are apparently the same in Japanese.

The deceased declared no assets and no liabilities to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file.

Tomekusa IDESHIMA had, apparently, once owned property at 518 Alexander Street, Vancouver, B. C. but he stated that he gave this property to his daughters as he was unable to pay the taxes. The property was registered in the names of Fumiko and Chiyoko DESHIMA and was sold by them prior to evacuation.

The B. C. Security Commission made claim for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 from the estate of the deceased to cover the cost of funeral expenses paid by the Commission in connection with his burial. They were advised by this office that the Estate was insolvent.
