
Securities: In his statement to the Custodian, Shigeo ITO declared that he owned four (4) \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, which were surrendered by him at the Immigration Office in Vancouver, B. C. These Certificates were forwarded to the Custodian by the R.C.M.P., on April 22nd, 1942. On October 2, 1942, ITO requested the Custodian to obtain the cash surrender value of these Certificates and on November 18, 1942, this office forwarded a cheque to him at the Camp, amounting to \$16.00, being full redemption value of four (4) \$5.00 War Savings Certificates.

Chattels Shigeo ITO also advised the Custodian that he had left two (2) cloth bags at 437 Alexander Street, Vancouver, B.C. After much investigation, one trunk, one small suitcase and 1 large duffel bag were removed from 466 East Cordova Street to the Custodian Warehouse at 992 Powell Street. On October 3, 1945, an auction of this man's effects was held, and the net amount of \$14.97 credited to his account with the Custodian.

On July 20th, 1943, the B. C. Security Commission forwarded to this office their cheque, amounting to \$3.85, for the credit of this Japanese. This amount represented a refund of transportation fare from Duncan to Vancouver on February 24, 1942.

All funds held at this office for the credit of the above noted Japanese person, were handed to him upon his repatriation to Japan on June 17, 1946.

DIARY DATE

SET FOR.....

1. On the evening of the 21st. inst. a raiding party composed of Csts. W.C. Wallace, H.E. Robson and the writer searched the premises of 437 Alexander St. Vancouver, and found the Subject residing there, it was found that he was ordered to leave for Dunster, Alta. on 30-3-42, he was questioned regarding this and he flatly refused to go to any work camp or to voluntarily leave the Defence Area. This man is a Japanese National, his Japanese Passport indicates that he returned from Japan Sept. 22nd. 1940. Subject is married but his wife is in Japan, has no children. He is described as follows: Age 26yrs., ht. 5'4" wt. 155 lbs. scar on right thumb. Black hair, brown eyes.

2. A search of the attic of 437 Alexander revealed the following interesting items, two wooden rifles, five wooden bayonets, four wooden swords, three tin swords and four steel Japanese swords. Also found in the attic were several small wooden stands with a cloth dummy the size and shape of a human head attached. Holes were found in the cloth dummies which indicated that they had been used for bayonet or sword practise. The attic was used as a store house at the time of the raid, however it ran the full length of the building and could have accommodated some 40 or 50 persons.

3. The apparent ownership of the above articles is laid to Ken. KIMURA who occupies the premises, it is claimed that the swords etc. were theatrical props., however the presence of the dummy does not bear this out. KIMURA is presently in the employ of the B.C. Security Commission at Hastings Park.

4. Also arrested at this time were three other Jap. Nationals, B.C. Refs. 422-269-358, 422-269-359, 422-269-360. These will be dealt with under their own file heading.

5. Attached are Forms 246 covering the above seizure, also Parole Certificate / 151620 is attached for cancellation.

6. Subject was arrested and escorted to the Immigration Bldg. where he was handed over to the Military Guard, a receipt was obtained and is attached hereto.
