Bank Account: On May 22, 1942, the Royal Bank of Canada, East End Branch, forwarded to this office their cheque, amounting to \$162.19, representing the credit balance of the above mentioned Internee with their Branch. These funds were deposited to the credit of the Internee at this office.

Securities: On June 27, 1942, Ishimatsu Hamakoji advised the Custodian that he had made two or three payments on a \$50.00 Victory Bond and that he wished to have these payments refunded to him. On July 18, 1942, the Canadian Bank of Commerce Kitsilano Branch, forwarded to this office their cheque, amounting to \$4.43, representing the Internee's equity in the \$50.00 Bond. These funds were credited to the Internee's account with the Custodian.

Life Insurance: On September 14, 1942, Ishimatsu HAMAKOJI forwarded to the Custodian, Life Insurance Policy No. 7,513,953, being a \$2,000.00 - 20 year endowment plan with the New York Life Insurance Company, and Policy No. 85,248, being a Disability Policy with the Mutual Benefit Health and Accident Association.

The New York Life Insurance Policy, above mentioned, was taken out on March 13, 1920, and matured on March 13, 1940. According to information received by telephone today, the Policy with the Mutual Benefit Health and Accident Association, dated May 13, 1938, has lapsed.

No property interests, other than the above-mentioned, are found on this file.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
