GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 464

December 18, 1946

Re: IMAI, Sakaye, #15104

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942.

The only property declared by Miss IMAI were the two War Savings Certificates, one \$10.00 and one \$50.00, which she stated were in her possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

On December 7, 1946, we received a letter from the Royal Bank of Canada, enclosing copy of letter from Miss Sakaye IMAI in regard to the bank balance in the account of her deceased father. The bank sent to this office the sum of \$98.82, which was the amount to the credit of the account of the late Matsutaro IMAI. These funds are now credited to the account of Mrs. Tsune IMAI, File 462, widow of Matsutaro IMAI and mother of Sakaye IMAI.

Apart from the bank balance, the only assets of the late Matsutaro IMAI of which this office has any record were the War Savings Certificates which his widow turned in for redemption. The sum of \$53.40, being redemption value of the Certificates, was received in this office on June 24, 1946. This money was remitted to Mrs. Tsune IMAI on September 3, 1946. It was thought at that time that these funds comprised the entire estate of Matsutaro IMAI, Deceased.
