No further action was taken by the Custodian.


PERSONAL PROPERTY:

The Internee States:-

"In replying to this letter M. Imada has not made any payment to me. I positively state that Imada is skillfully and cunningly trying to avoid making payment. The said amount, the sum of \$48.55 is only balance of the judgement of \$238.53. Imada owes me besides this \$48.55. Unfortunately I could not estimate exact amount unless I see my record book which is in my school in New Westminster, B. C. Imada and his wife are well known undesirable persons amongst Japanese".

Your file 466.

We are in receipt of your letter of the first instant and regret our oversight in not replying to your letter of September 16th last.

On February 21st 1935 we recovered judgment in the County Court of Westminster for our client T. H. Tanaka against one M. Imada for \$238.53 and this judgment of course bears interest at 5% from its date.

We registered the judgment against Imada's real estate described as Lot 16 Block 3 of the East half of Section 11 Township 1 Map 1334 in the Municipality of Surrey. In July 1935 Imada sold this property to one Minnie Rees and out of the proceeds of the sale the sum of \$200.00 was paid to us by Imada and he instructed us in writing to distribute it as follows:

The sum of \$100.00 on account of Tanaka's judgment against Imada.

The sum of \$20.00 on account of the costs of registration of the judgment and the preparation of the release of said judgment.

The sum of \$1.00 for registration fee of release of judgment.

The balance of \$79.00 to T. Iwasa. ✓

The registration of the judgment was duly discharged in the Land Registry Office and the above-mentioned sum of \$79.00 was paid by us to Iwasa as directed by Imada.

There then remained a balance of \$138.53 owing on the judgment plus interest at 5% from its date to

November relative to the above Japanese.

We have noted the contents carefully and before
writing to TANAKA and IMADA we should be obliged if you would
state if TANAKA has received payment from you of the collections
mentioned, namely, \$100.00 plus \$70.00 or a total of \$170.00, less
your charges. We have quoted to you from letters from TANAKA
and IMADA and you are, therefore, aware of their contentions. It
seems from the figures you submitted in your letter that there must
be about \$73.50 plus interest from July 1935 on unpaid balances
from time to time still due to TANAKA on account of the Judgment
claim.

Please state if this is approximately the correct
amount so that we may have a definite figure on which to base
our report to them.

Kindly favour us with an early reply.

We are in receipt of your letter of the
17th ultimo.

You are correct in suggesting that Tanaka
received payment of the amounts of \$100.00 and \$70.00
although the monies were not actually paid to him. They
were credited on our account against him.

The balance owing on the judgment according
to our records will be \$138.53 less \$70.00 plus interest at
5% from the date of the judgment on unpaid balances from time
to time.

We are perfectly willing to give you any
information that you may wish to have but frankly we are
becoming somewhat tired of the dispute between Tanaka and
Imada as to the balance owing. Tanaka still owes us \$25.50
and it might not be out of the way for us to suggest that he
pay our account.
