PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Hidehiro IKEGAMI, Registration No. 11165

In his declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942, this man, who was evacuated on March 25, 1942, declared that he was the owner of 3 nets stored at Claxton Cannery, Skeena River, and a fishing net winch stored at Claxton Cannery. British Columbia Packers Ltd., who operate Claxton Cannery, have informed that the company settled with the Japanese for all fishing gear before the Japanese left the plant in 1942. The company further states that there is no private gear of any kind at Claxton which may belong to persons of Japanese origin.

IKEGAMI reported \$5.00 in War Saving Certificates. This did not come under the control of this office.

No other property of any kind is revealed by this file.
