In his Statement of Assets and Liabilities, dated May 11, 1942, the above noted Internee declared that he held ten \$5.00 War Savings Certificates at the Internment Camp. These Certificates were forwarded to the Custodian on June 15, 1942, and on December 17, 1942, Toshio Matsumoto requested the Custodian to arrange for the cash surrender value of these Certificates, and forward the proceeds to him.

A cheque for the sum of \$40.52 was received from the Registrar, War Savings Certificates, Ottawa, on February 1, 1943, and these funds were subsequently liquidated by remittances to the Internee at the Camp.

No property interests, other than the above mentioned, appear on this file.


