



I am repatriating on this coming boat. So is it possible for me to receive his credit or if not will you please send it direct to him in Japan.

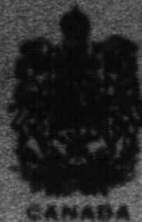

File No. 494 dated December 22nd 1943.

The Internee states:-

" In connection with my credit balance with the Office of the Custodian I wish to state that there is still twenty-nine dollars (\$29.00) at least outstanding in my credit on account of the refund made to me for my transportation, fare etc. which according to the information given to me by the B.C. Security Commission made on or about April 12th. 1943. And I made the request out of that credit I mentioned above in my letter of the 16th inst.

So far I have received remittances of twenty five dollars at the last part of January this year and twenty three 52/100 dollars at the first part of June this year, totalling to forty-eight 52/100 dollars (\$48.52) being proceeds of redemption value of my twelve (12) five dollar War Savings Certificates. But I have not received any part of the refund of the said transportation. Kindly make full check up in this connection."
