PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 505

April 9, 1946.

Re: Helen (Mrs. Tetsuzo) MITOBE, #7559

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 4, 1942. She was evacuated from the protected area on September 15, 1942.

In her declaration she reported 17 pieces of household effects left at Port Alberni. On May 20, 1942 11 pieces were shipped to her at Hastings Park and 6 pieces, including a stove not declared by Mrs. MITOBE, were transferred to the storage warehouse of William Burnip in Port Alberni. A 100-lb. sack of Rice, among the items declared by Mrs. MITOBE, was discarded as it had been eaten by mice.

In October, 1942, Mrs. MITOBE wrote informing us about the stove and requesting that all her chattels remaining at Port Alberni be sent to her. We arranged for this to be done but in November, 1942, Mrs. MITOBE wrote that the spring for the bed had not arrived. We notified the B.C. Security Commission of this shortage and assume that this was located as there is nothing further on the file about it.

This woman declared a \$100.00 Victory Bond, a \$50.00 Victory Bond and \$75.00 in War Saving Certificates. She also declared a bank account with a balance of \$550.00 in the Bank of Commerce, Port Alberni Branch. None of these items came under the control of this office.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

I wish to report that when I gave my list of goods left in care of Provincial Police at Port Alberni I omitted to write down one box, unlabelled, containing my kitchen stove. Please advise if you have it in your care.

I was informed that all the goods left in care of Custodian at Vancouver Island will be shipped to their respective owners in November in one large lot. If that is the case could it be possible to have my bed, (in three pieces, i.e. sides, feet & back and spring) dressing table with mirror packed in another container and my stove. I understand I have to get a written permission from Mr. Tarry before you'd

release the goods but I wrote to tell
you of my omission when I made my
original list about my kitchen stone.

Please let me ^{know} at an early
date if you have my stone.
