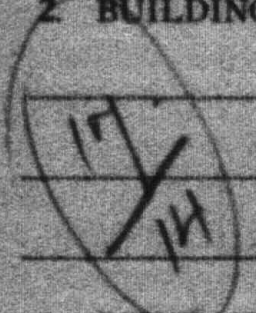

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

May 9, 1946.

Re: Fulle (Mrs. Hirokichi) HAMA, Registration No. 12064

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 4, 1942. She was evacuated on September 19, 1942.

In her declaration she reported sewing machine and kitchen utensils being sent to Vancouver. She acknowledged receiving these in a letter written December 30, 1942.

In her declaration she reported \$15.00 in War Saving Certificates in her own possession and a bank account with a balance of \$1,000.00. These items did not come under the control of this office.

A heater and parts were left by her husband at Hastings Park. These were sold at auction and the net proceeds were credited to this woman's account in the amount of \$60.04. As this would appear to be credited to the wrong file we are transferring this amount to the account of her husband, File No. 1744.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.




