

MEMORANDUM

TO: MR. K. W. WRIGHT

FROM: MR. G. H. PEERS

RE: Harry Shuzu TSURUDA'S Debt to
Terasu SHIRAISHI, \$20.00

This debt is acknowledged to be owed to SHIRAISHI by TSURUDA who has requested that we make payment in his letter of March 20th, 1944.

Neither party mentioned the debt when informing the Custodian of their assets and liabilities.

The B.C. Security Commission object to the payment of the debt if it had not previously been declared, although they allowed payment from TSURUDA'S funds of a remittance to his Interned son, Susumu TSURUDA, of \$25.00 and payment of the son's debts as follows:

W. F. Quarrie & Company	\$27.18
Vancouver General Hospital	1.00
TOTAL	\$28.18

TSURUDA'S balance at present is \$661.85 and his exemption amounts to \$770.00.

Should this debt be paid contrary to the B.C. Security Commission's instructions?

Further to my statement of Assets and Liabilities re claims, I would like to mention that I now found that Masatoshi KOGA, who had an account payable to me amounting to thirty dollars (\$30.00) is at present working at c/o G. P. Ry. Co., White River, Ontario. Kindly therefore, collect the amount from his, then credit it to my account with your office.

Also another claim, amounting to twenty dollars (\$20.00) which I missed to state in the statement is to Mr. Shuzo TSURUDA, now of Sandon, B. C., and formerly of 706 East Cordova St., Vancouver, B. C. This is a personal loan to him, and recently I had words from him stating that he is willing to pay the amount to me out of his account with your office. Therefore, collect the amount from his account after getting his consent, then credit it to my account with your office.
