In her declaration to the Custodian, April 4, 1942, this woman, who was evacuated on July 21, 1942, declared the following:

Bank Account: Bank of Nova Scotia, Hastings & Seymour, Vancouver, \$1,000.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Life Insurance: Prudential Policy for \$700.00, in her own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The file shows an interest in the following personal effects:

Chattels: Eight pieces of Household effects were shipped to Mrs. Yano on May 25, 1942, from Port Alice via CPR. These effects were declared by Masayuki YANO, File 2126, husband of this woman. In all nine pieces were declared by Masayuki YANO. The ninth turned out to be a heater, which was reported as being left in his former residence at Port Alice. C. A. Bellhouse, of the B. C. Police, Port Alice, investigated this, but could find no trace of the heater.

Camera: Mrs. Lilian Monks reported that she had in her custody a movie camera belonging to this woman. This camera appears to be still in the care of Mrs. Monks. We have advised Mrs. Yano that it may be shipped.

This file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.
